The 5th Annual Oaken Bucket Run is quickly approaching! On Saturday October 12th, supporters of the rivalry between the Indiana Hoosiers and Purdue Boilermakers football teams (among many others) will gather for a 5K Run or 2 mile walk to raise money for the Oaken Bucket scholarship held at the Steuben County Community Foundation. The Old Oaken Bucket is a traveling trophy awarded to the winner of this historic rivalry; a replica is maintained in the SCCF office. Money raised from this event provides a scholarship to a Steuben County student attending any Indiana University campus and one to a student attending any Purdue University campus.
