In 2011, Joyce Gutstein established the Alfred R. and Joyce E. Gutstein Nursing Scholarship in memory of her late husband. Alfred was a prominent attorney in Angola where he practiced for over 50 years and he was very active in the community. Joyce is a registered nurse and was involved in many community projects focusing on the welfare of women and children. She was a major organizer of the Well Child Clinic in Angola and served as nurse coordinator for 22 years. She was also instrumental in starting Santa's Helpers, served as chairman and volunteered for 30 years. Jack Curtis, the first full-time director of the community foundation, was a dear friend and introduced her to the community foundation.

Joyce was honored to be present at this year's scholarship recognition dinner, where she was able to meet the two recipients of her scholarship. She said, "They were outstanding candidates and I was so pleased to meet them. I enjoy working with the community foundation because I provided the funding....but they did all of the work in selecting the best candidates!" She further stated, "The community needs to know that they need to give back when they're in a position to do so. Angola has been very good to my husband and I, so now it's our turn to be good back."
