The Steuben County Community Foundation's Annual Public Board Meeting was held on June 20th, 2013 to discuss share the foundation's progress over the past fiscal year. Outgoing board chair, Dan Caruso opened the meeting with a moment of silence for the passing of Jack Curtis, the foundation's first full time director.

Treasurer Kevin Stoy reported that for the first time since its establishment, the foundation's assets top \$20 million. Of the foundation's total assets, 92 percent are permanently endowed. Over the past year, SCCF has granted out over \$1 million dollars to the Steuben County community. This was made possible through a variety of vehicles established by donors to fulfill their charitable wishes.

SCCF's supporting organization, [iMAN](#), a community-owned fiber network, continues to grow. In 2013, the network grew to 56 monthly paid connections, generating \$127,000 in revenue. 16 percent of that income was granted back to the community, totaling over \$21,000.

But most important to our mission of connecting people who care with needs that matter, the foundation established four new funds over the past year:

- Steuben County Economic Development Corporation Fund was established by the organization's board of directors to provide ongoing support for the EDC to carry out its mission.
- Michael David Holcomb Memorial IT Scholarship was established by Michael's parents, Michael and Donna and twin brother Travis. This scholarship seeks to provide support to a Prairie Heights graduating senior or alumni pursuing a degree in Information Technology. Tragically at the age of 36, Michael lost his life in a hit and run accident.
- Donald W. Rogers Vocational Educational Grant Fund was funded by a trust left by Don Rogers to care for his wife Martha after his death. After Martha's passing in late 2012, the residue of this trust was gifted to the foundation. Earnings from this fund are designated for the Angola Rotary Club and Angola Elks Club to administer vocational educational grants through their respective club's programs.
- Martha Rogers Fund was funded by the estate of the late

This summer F.I.S.T., the foundation's youth pod, is hosting an event that is called the FIST Fast Dash 2013. The Fast Dash will be held on July 27 at the YMCA.

The FIST Fast Dash 2013 is a race where contestants race against the clock to do or find things all around Steuben County. There are three categories (Things to do, Challenges, and Clues) that contestants can do to receive a variety of points. Contestants will take pictures or videos for evidence that they completed the challenge. The top three contestants with the most points will get a cash donation to the non-profit of their choice.
