## Competitive Grants Awarded

The Foundation has just completed its final grant cycle of the fiscal year. These local organizations were approved for funding during the sixth grant cycle:

- Hoosiers Feeding the Hungry - \$5,000 to assist with processing meat donated to Steuben County food pantries
- Camp Watcha Wanna Do - \$2,200 for summer camp fees for cancer patients from Steuben County
- Girl Scouts of NE Indiana - \$1,500 for leadership training for Steuben County girls
- Steuben County Literacy Coalition - \$7,500 for after school education programs for Steuben County schools
- Junior Achievement of NE Indiana - \$5,000 for Global Economics programs in Steuben County schools
- Steuben County Humane Society - \$7,134.24 for Pet Over Population Prevention Program (spay and neuter program for Steuben County animals)
- Community Harvest Food Bank - \$7,134.24 for Farm Wagon supplies (fresh produce and food for local food pantries)

In the 2013 fiscal year, \$173,555.62 was granted to local organizations in and around Steuben County from the board of directors discretionary fund, as advised by a volunteer grants committee.
