## Kings Leave Legacy in Steuben County

The Steuben County Community Foundation recently learned of the passing of Richard "Dick" King. Dick, and his late wife Virginia "Peg" King, were long-time residents and friends of Steuben County. Dick was a WWII U.S. Navy sailor and owned an excavating business, King Construction, in Angola for many years. He had a well-known passion for the local Humane Shelter and for dogs (owning many). Peg worked for over 35 years in the accounting department of Dana-Weatherhead in Angola. After their time in Angola, they spent their final decades near Cedar Lake in Howe, Indiana.

In 2003 Dick and Peg donated a piece of real estate on Wholert Street to SCCF. The proceeds of the sale established a [charitable gift annuity](#) that benefited Dick and Peg for over 11 years. Upon Dick's death earlier this year, the remaining assets were transferred to two causes
