Prelude to the Playlist - this weekend!

The Steuben County Community Foundation is pleased to partner with Trine University to offer a premier musical event in our community. On Sunday November 2nd at 2:00 PM the Fort Wayne Philharmonic will be performing a Masterworks Series Concert at the T. Furth Center for Performing Arts on the campus of Trine University in Angola, IN.

In a shift of how the community foundation stewards its endowment fund donors and encourages support from others in the community, the board of directors decided to gather and celebrate its donor community through a different event format this year. The concert is being made possible through a series of sponsorships and endowment fund donors. The attendees will enjoy a concert of 65 musicians, led by conductor Francesco Lecce-Chong, featuring Vivaldi's Concerto for Two Cellos, Charles Avison's Concerto Grosso No.5 juxtaposed with the brilliance of Stravinsky's Dumbarton Oaks, and Brahms Symphony No.2. SCCF is very excited to be able to offer such a respected and rare treat for our community.

Proceeds from the event will benefit SCCF's community grantmaking endowment which grants \$250,000+ a year to a variety of nonprofit organizations serving Steuben County.

2015 Scholarships Available Soon

The Steuben County Community Foundation will continue to use an online scholarship program in 2015. The donor-established scholarships managed by SCCF are available on a secure website available November 1st. This online program limits the amount of paper used, creates an easier way for applicants to apply and ensures the anonymity of each applicant.

Each applicant who wishes to apply for scholarships will complete a common application in the online program. This common application will then match him/her to corresponding scholarships that he/she is eligible for. Once they are matched to scholarships, they will choose which scholarships they would like to complete. After selecting a scholarship, the common application information will be automatically entered into the unique scholarship application. The applicant will then be requested to finish the unique application. Applicants will be able to do this individually for all scholarships they are matched with.

The scholarships will be available November 1st, at www.steubenfoundation.org/scholarships. The Deadline to apply is February 15th, 2015 at 11:59 PM.
