

Fremont Chamber invests in iMAN

— The Fremont Chamber of Commerce has invested \$2,011 in the Indiana Metropolitan Area Network fiber optic infrastructure building fund.

“The

Chamber Board of Directors felt it was an important investment in the future of the Fremont community. The mission of the Chamber is to support and improve the businesses in our community, and the importance of having a fiber optic backbone will enhance our marketing efforts to retain and attract investment and bring new jobs to our town and the whole area,” said chamber President Linda Fulton.

In October

2010, the Steuben County Commissioners and Council approved a \$2 million appropriation from Major Moves, leaving iMAN officials with another \$562,000 to raise in order to complete the project all over Steuben County.

“Including this gift, the total raised is now over \$127,000, which is great, but we know we still have work to do” said
