The mission of the Humanities Fund is to increase awareness of, and participation in the many facets of the humanities by Steuben County residents of all ages. *Imaginative proposals* for projects that are as varied as performances, exhibits, multi-cultural experiences, workshops, and readings on topics ranging from the traditional humanities to those less often recognized such as gardening, cuisine, and the crafts are eligible.

Grants up to \$500 will be awarded.

The Humanities Fund, which originated from a Challenge Grant awarded by the Indiana Humanities Council, follows the grant guidelines established by the Board of Directors of SCCF. Funds will not normally be used to support advertising, travel, projects outside our area, general operations, and/or individuals. Grants from the endowment fund are for supporting awareness of the arts and humanities through projects and programs thus strengthening the creative fiber of Steuben County.
