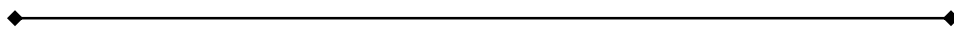
Established by Mary Jane Kruse through her estate in 2007, this scholarship provides support to two students who will be majoring in English at an accredited college or university of their choice.

Mary Jane Kruse began her career teaching English for one year in Defiance, Ohio, and following that year she spent six years teaching English at the Fremont Community Schools. In 1974 she began at the Metropolitan School District of Steuben County where she taught English at Angola High School for the next 26 years. Ms. Kruse asked that a scholarship be established through her estate to provide help with the first year of college expenses for two students interested in majoring in English. Ms. Kruse's generosity will help many young people of Steuben County over the years.

Requirements:

- The recipient(s) must be a graduating senior from a Steuben County high school (Angola High School, Fremont High School, Hamilton High School, Prairie Heights High School); a non-traditional student (returning back after an absence since graduating from high school); or, home schooled students who are a Steuben County Resident.
- The recipients must be majoring in English
- The recipients must attend an accredited institution of higher education.
- Scholarship may be used for tuition only.
- Attachments requested are provided along with the application.

Selection Committee:

- Steuben County Community Foundation Scholarship Committee

Award

- Two scholarships will be granted with the target amount of the award per student of \$2,500.00 (dependent upon investment returns).
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the college/university to be deposited into the recipient's account.

Miscellaneous

- If a recipient fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Mary Jane Kruse Memorial Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made with the approval of Steuben County Community Foundation Board.
