The Prairie Heights Building Trades Scholarship is provided to support a student who is pursuing a career in the construction, other vocational careers, or an academic program. The student(s) must have been in Building Trades class during their senior year to be eligible.

Prairie Heights Building Trades has been building homes in the community since 1971. The program has taught hundreds of young people the art of carpentry. Several of the students have gone on to find careers in the construction field as well. Others have simply used the knowledge they gained to help them with their own personal projects.

This award is in support of carrying on the long-standing tradition of the Prairie Heights Building Trades Program. This program has served as a tool to help our community grow and by awarding this scholarship we hope to encourage many more students to enter the construction and/or academic field.

# *The Prairie Heights Building Trades Scholarship*

## **Requirements:**

- The student(s) must be a senior attending Prairie Heights High School and be enrolled in a building trades curriculum. The student(s), upon graduation from high school, must attend an accredited 2 or 4 year post secondary vocational or academic program.
- The student(s) must complete the 1<sup>st</sup> semester satisfactorily and be registered for the second semester of post secondary vocational education in order to be eligible.

## **Selection Committee:**

- Prairie Heights High School Principal
- Building Trades Teacher
- Prairie Heights School Board Member
- 2 community members at large to be selected by the PHHS Building Trades Committee. They could be current members of the PHHS Building Trades Committee.
- Representative from the Steuben County Community Foundation.

## **Award:**

- Two scholarships will be awarded annually with the target amount of the award to be \$500.00 per student.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to the college/university to be deposited into the recipient's account after completion of the recipient's first semester of post-secondary education. The Steuben County Community Foundation will provide the recipient with an Award Voucher form to fill out and return to the Scholarship Associate at the end of his/her first semester of college, in order to have his/her college receive the scholarship proceeds for the second semester.

## **Miscellaneous**

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Prairie Heights Building Trades Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the Prairie Heights Schools Superintendent.
