Established by the family and friends of Leon Huss as a living memorial, the Leon Huss 4 –H Memorial Scholarship provides financial support to a 4-H student who will be continuing his or her education at a college or university.

As a youngster, Leon was a member of 4-H for 10 years. He showed Guernsey cows and was the proud winner of the 1954 District Tractor-driving Contest Senior Division. The 4-H program continued to be important to him throughout his life. Both he and his wife Sharon, along with their three children – Gene, Dan and Shari, farmed their family farm. Leon and Sharon were strong supporters of the 4-H auction with donations and buying animals.

For over 25 years they owned Oliver Sales Company in Angola. Leon rebuilt several old Oliver tractors and drove them in local parades.

The Leon Huss 4-H Memorial Scholarship

Requirements:

- The student(s) must be a Steuben County resident
- The student(s) must be a graduating senior from any Steuben County high school.
- The student must be admitted to a college or university
- The student must have completed at least four years of 4-H and be a current member
- Required attachments are submitted with application

Selection Process:

- Selection is made by the Steuben County Community Foundation's Scholarship Committee.

Award:

- Award is for one year.
- The scholarship will be paid directly to college/university to be deposited into the recipient's account.

Miscellaneous:

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Leon Huss 4-H Memorial Scholarship fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the Huss family.
