The John W. Kelley Memorial Scholarship was established in memory of John Kelley, who passed away in May 2003, by his friend and local businessman Frank Baade. This scholarship gives financial support to students interested in earning a degree in Law Enforcement Education. John Kelley was a member of the Steuben County Sheriff's Department Merit Board. He was known to give a "fair ear" to the police officers of Steuben County as they strived to maintain their high standards of honesty, integrity and professionalism.

A Vietnam veteran, John served his country in the U.S. Army 208th Military Police Detachment. He was responsible for security, law enforcement and training.

Requirements:

- The student(s) must be a Steuben County resident.
- The student(s) must be a graduating senior from any Steuben County high school.
- The student(s) must be pursuing a degree in Law Enforcement Education.
- Preference is given in the following manner:
 1. Children of active duty Steuben County Sheriff's office employees
 2. Children of any active duty law enforcement affiliation such as State Police, local Police Officers of Steuben County jurisdiction, DNR, Conservation officers, etc...
 3. Any student
- Attachments requested are provided along with the application.
- Scholarship is not renewable.

Selection committee:

- S.C. Sheriff's Dept. Deputies Assoc. President
- Designee annually from the Deputies Assoc.
- S.C. Sheriff's Dept. Merit Board officers as follows:
 1. Deputy's pick for Board (Democrat)
 2. Deputy's pick for Board (Republican)
- Representative(s) of the Steuben County Community Foundation.

Miscellaneous:

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the John W. Kelley Memorial Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the selection committee.
