- The student(s) must be entering higher education in the field of marine technology, including, but not limited to: mechanics, retail management, sales or education instruction.

Selection committee:

- The Steuben County Community Foundation's Scholarship Committee

Miscellaneous:

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Lakeland Marine Retailers Association Scholarship Fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
