Gerald J. Seagly was a lifelong resident of Steuben County, a successful businessman and a person dedicated to helping the youth in the area. He served as chairman of the Student Loan Program for the local Rotary Club and helped to raise money to perpetuate this fund. Mr. Seagly made provisions in his will for the gift of scholarship money to Hamilton High School. The money was held in trust to benefit his surviving spouse, Waunetta, during her lifetime. Waunetta released her life interest in the trust income to the schools so that it would benefit deserving students who were going to continue their education.

Requirements:

- The student to be considered must reside in Steuben County and be enrolled as a senior in the Hamilton Community Schools.
- The recipient of the scholarship must attend an accredited school within the boundaries of the United States. The program may vary from a one-year program upwards.
- The main criteria that will be used in reviewing the applications is academic achievement, academic potential, general citizenship, and financial need. Other factors may be considered, but are not as important as those mentioned.

Selection Committee:

- High school principal, guidance counselors, invited members of the faculty, and SCCF Scholarship Representative

Miscellaneous:

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses. The award is sent to the school to be placed in the student's account.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Gerald J. and Waunetta B. Seagly Scholarship, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of the Hamilton School Board of Education.
