Gregory Michael Shively was a 1976 graduate of Fremont High School. He began his college career at Purdue University and graduated from Michigan State University in an Agriculture Program. After college he joined his father and brother in the farming operation. Greg was a 10-year 4-H member. He was active in FFA, school plays, track, and a member of his church youth group. He enjoyed outdoor activities including snowmobiling and motorcycling. After his death in 1981, his family established The Greg Shively Memorial Scholarship as an ongoing and living memorial.

The Greg Shively Memorial Scholarship

Requirements:

- The student must be a graduating senior from Fremont High School.
- The student must be continuing their education at the institution of higher education and enrolled in a certified or degreed program.
- NOTE: special consideration will be given to those students who have participated in 4-H. Please provide 4-H record with application, if applicable.

Selection committee:

- Member(s) of the Shively family
- Representative(s) of the Steuben County Community Foundation Scholarship Committee
- Minimum of three persons

Miscellaneous:

- The scholarship may be used for tuition, books, supplies, room & board, or other school-related expenses.
- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Greg Shively Memorial Scholarship fund, or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of, and with the approval of the Shively family.
