Harold and Helen Stevens were both interested in the education of young people. Very early in their lives, they both were teachers. Harold taught at Flint School, and Helen began her teaching career in a one-room schoolhouse in Steuben County. Throughout their lives together she supported her husband's continued interest in education. Harold founded Lakeland Electronics in Angola, and for 16 years he served as a board member on the Metropolitan School District (MSD) of Steuben County. He remained a vocal activist of the MSD school district until his death in 1992. Helen was a homemaker and mother of three daughters. She was active in her church until her death in 2001.

In memory of their parents, daughters Beverly Laird, Donna Hays and Nancy Riley established the Harold H. and Helen E. Stevens Memorial Scholarship to provide support to students enrolled in the College of Education at Trine University.

- The student must be a graduating senior from Angola, Fremont, Hamilton or Prairie Heights high school.
- The student must be entering the College of Education at Trine University.
- The recipient is eligible to reapply.

Selection criteria:

- If there is no qualified student entering this field, the award may be directed to a student maintaining higher education in this field.

Selection committee:

- Representatives of the Steuben County Community Foundation
- Minimum of three persons

Miscellaneous:

- If the student fails to attend as planned, the college will be instructed to return the scholarship money to the Steuben County Community Foundation to be deposited in the Harold H. and Helen E. Stevens Memorial Scholarship Fund., or an alternate could be awarded the scholarship.
- Modifications to the criteria above can be made at the request of and with the approval of the Stevens' family.
