#1: Revisit and rewrite SCCF's current grant guidelines and process to focus more on impact and outcomes.

#2: Provide the appropriate education and training to board, grants committee and nonprofit organizations once the new Impact Based Grantmaking guidelines are in place.

#3: Develop system of measurement for SCCF for the next 3-5 years to understand and share their impact on the community at large.
